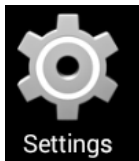


How to setup Office 365 on Android.

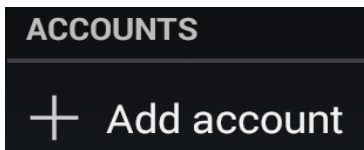

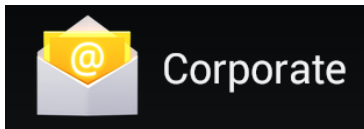
1. Go to setting



2. Click Add Account

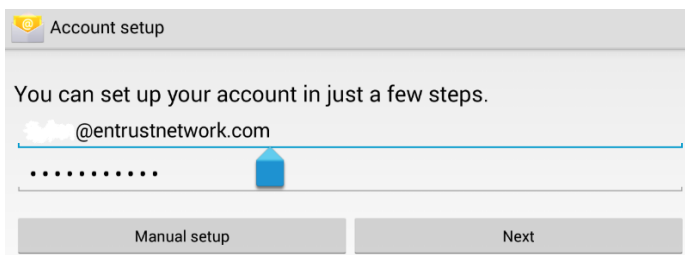


3. Then select Microsoft Exchange or Corporate



(in my case I choose Corporate but if you have Microsoft Exchange then you select Microsoft exchange)

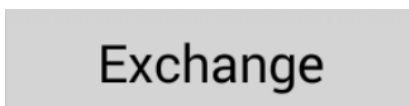
4. Key in the necessary details, click Next




Email: example@entrustnetwork.com (Do not follow the email on the picture above this is just a dummy address, use your own email address that you want to setup)



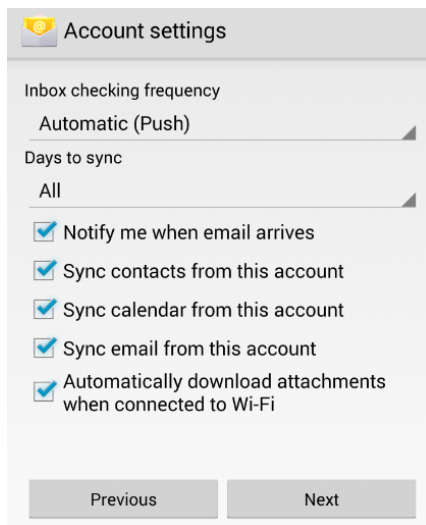
7. When finishes verifying, it will prompt out a permission. Just click OK to continue.



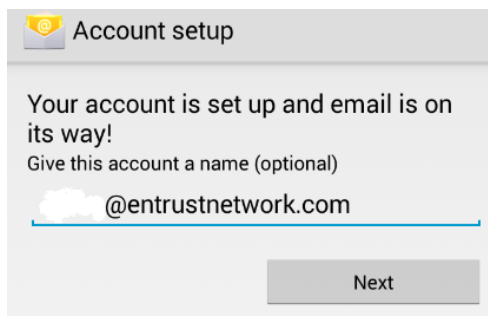
 Remote security administration

8. Choose which day you want to sync your email. Then click Next



9. You can give your account a name for it to display. Click Next to continue.



10. Click activate to activate the administrator on the email and you are done with it. Then open the email that you have created and let it synchronize.
