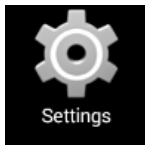


How to setup IMAP email on Android smartphones

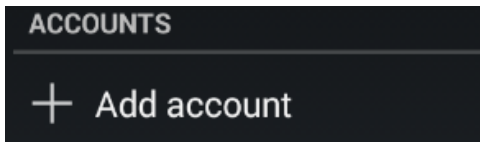

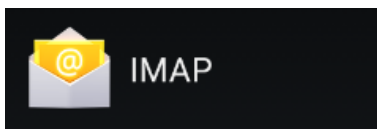
1. Go to setting



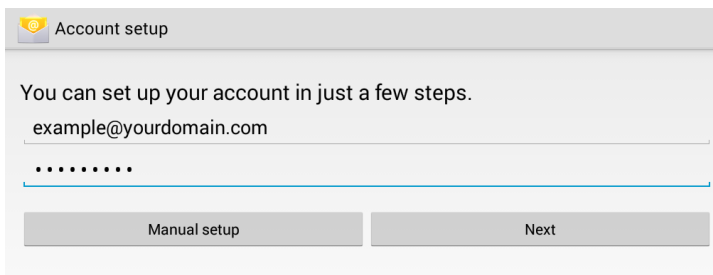
2. Click setting, scroll down until you saw **Accounts**, click on **Add Account**



3. Select IMAP to continue



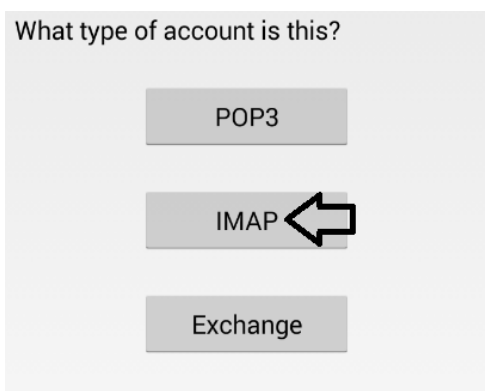
4. Enter all the details in the required field to proceed, Click Next




Email: example@yourdomain.com



(This is the easiest way to differentiate between accounts if you have more than 1)

Your name: Your name as you want it to display on email messages.
