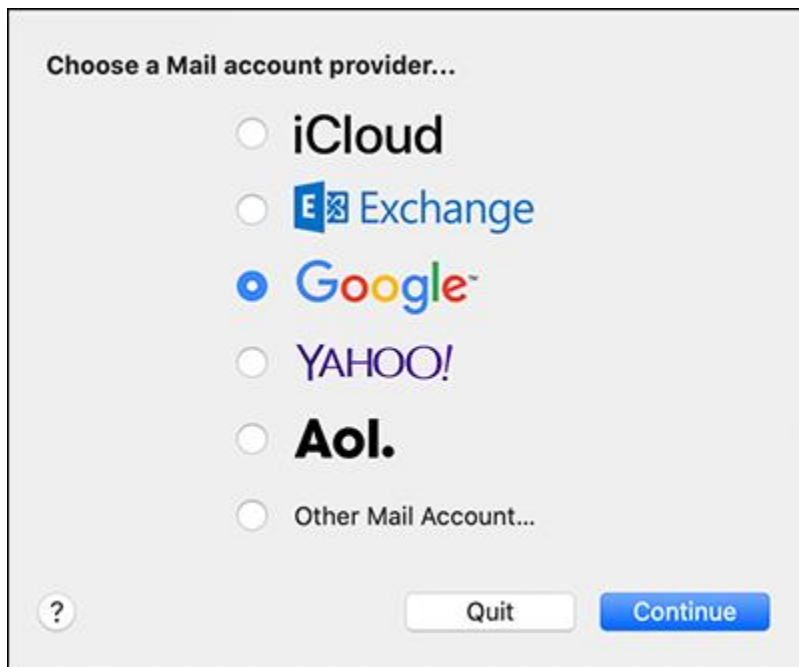


## How to setup G Suite on Mac Mail

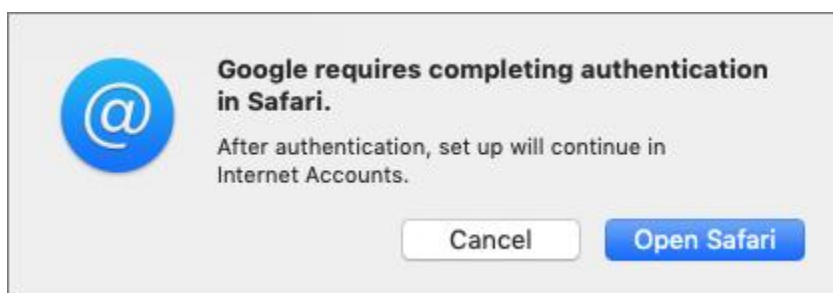
Open “Apple Mail” on your computer

Click Mail > Add Account


Select Google and click “Continue”



Click on “Open Safari” if prompted




Key in your email address and password and click "Next"
